Dear Minister

I am writing to convey the outcomes from the 40th meeting of the Sydney Airport Community Forum (SACF) held on 11 June 2004.

The main item on the agenda was a presentation by Airplan in which they provided a summary of their preliminary findings. Essentially, Airplan indicated that the noise sharing goals in terms of runway end impacts has not been achieved for all runway ends but found no obvious factors or areas where significant improvements could be achieved. Members were encouraged that air traffic managers were shown to be making appropriate mode allocations however it was acknowledged that the targets may require review.

Outstanding details regarding the role and responsibilities expected from the position of Aviation Community Advocate were finalised and it was agreed that the Advocate will attend future Forum meetings to provide regular activity reports.

SACL provided members with a presentation on the development of their preliminary draft Environmental Strategy for 2005-2010. Members were advised that the preliminary draft will be available for public comment from 1 July 2004.

Members continued to express concerns about the protection of current and future airspace requirements for Sydney Airport and these issues will be discussed further at the next Forum meeting in September.

Concern was also raised about proposed residential rezoning of areas within ANEF contours at Kurnell and more generally, in other known noise affected areas surrounding the airport. These issues will also be discussed further with the council representatives at the next meeting.
